

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

Incentive and Endowment

Performance Based Incentive Standards (PBIS)

In order to track progress and objectively evalute local Smart Start Partnerships based on outcomes and results, a performance based incentive system was created. Smart Start Partnerships are the community-level leaders in establishing a comprehensive early education system where every child has the services they need to enter school ready to succeed. More than 20 criteria have been established in four key areas administration, early care and education, health, and family support. There standards focus the work and resources of Smart Start partnerships in targeted ways that truly make a difference in areas that are proven to impact a child's readiness for Kindergarten. Our Partnership has met high performing standards in all criteria with the exception of one where minimum was met.

Margaret Blount Harvey Endowment

In May of 2002, the Partnership Board approved the establishment of an educational endowment at Lenoir Community College in honor of Margaret Harvey. Mrs. Harvey was instrumental in the formation of the Partnership for Children of Lenoir and Greene Counties, as well as providing guidance and leadership during the early years of the Partnership. The endowment provides a scholarship for a student who plans to pursue an Associate's Degree in Early Childhood Education.
