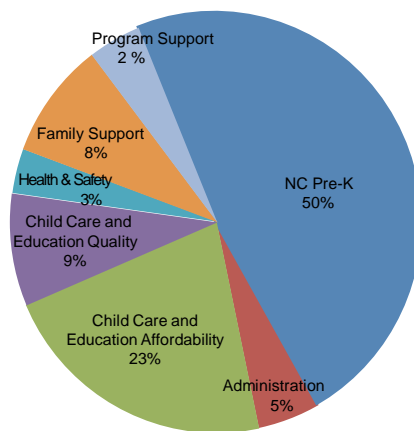

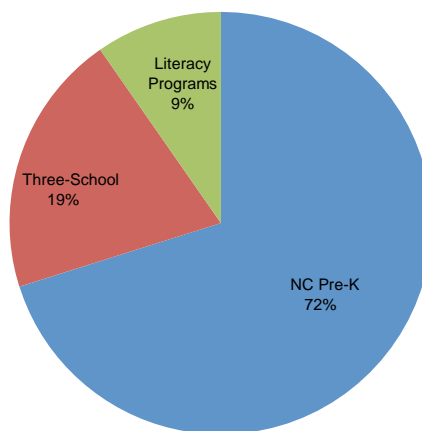

The Community Early Childhood Profile (EC Profile) provides an annual snapshot of the status of our young children. It includes indicators of child well-being for which local Smart Start Partnerships are held accountable.

The EC Profile assess progress towards realizing Smart Start's mission of advancing a high quality, comprehensive, accountable early childhood system that benefits each child in North Carolina beginning with a healthy birth.

The report uses validated data from state agencies that directly impact young children such as the NC Department of Health and Human services, the NC Department of Public Instruction, and the NC Office of State Budget and Management.

Child Care Quality and Resources (CCQR)

Professional Development

- 208 staff participated in professional development

Technical Assistance (TA)

- 81 facilities participated in workshops
- 41 workshops conducted
- 51 facilities participated in technical assistance

Resource Center

- 58 members used our resource centers

Preschool and Quality

Child Care to Support Literacy

- The Quality Child Care to Support Literacy program (Lenoir County) served 10 children through funding provided by the Partnership.
- The Preschool to Support Literacy program (Greene County) served 16 children through funding provided by the Partnership.

NC Pre-Kindergarten Program (NC Pre-K)

- NC Pre-K served 257 children in 17 classrooms.

Three-School Program

- Three-School served 64 children in 4 classrooms.

Child Care Health Consultation (CCHC)

- The CCHC served 47 facilities.
- 247 providers (teaching staff) served through on site consultation.

Community Outreach

- 60 community events
- 339 parents/guardians were reached
