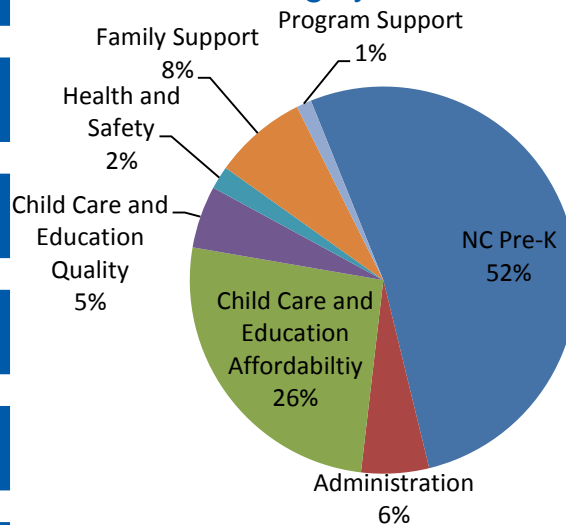

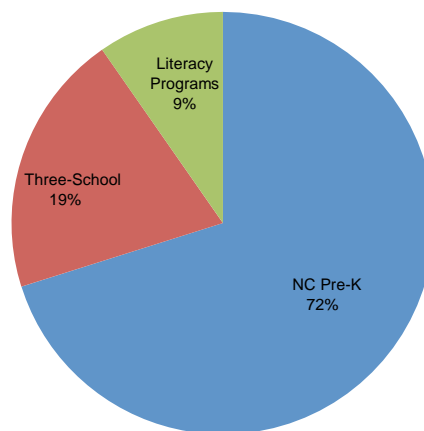

The EC Profile assess progress towards realizing Smart Start's mission of advancing a high quality, comprehensive, accountable early childhood system that benefits each child in North Carolina beginning with a healthy birth.

The report uses validated data from state agencies that directly impact young children such as the NC Department of Health and Human services, the NC Department of Public Instruction, and the NC Office of State Budget and Management.

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Partnership Programs and Services

Child Care Quality and Resources (CCQR)

Professional Development

- 109 staff participated in professional development
- 25 workshops conducted

Technical Assistance (TA)

- 99 classrooms received technical assistance
- 36 facilities participated in technical assistance

Resource Center

- 91 members used our resource centers

Preschool and Quality

Child Care to Support Literacy

- The Quality Child Care to Support Literacy program (Lenoir County) served 10 children through funding provided by the Partnership.
- The Preschool to Support Literacy program (Greene County) served 12 children through funding provided by the Partnership.

NC Pre-Kindergarten Program (NC Pre-K)

- NC Pre-K served 257 children in 17 classrooms.

Three-School Program

- Three-School served 64 children in 4 classrooms.

Child Care Health Consultation (CCHC)

- The CCHC served 33 facilities.

Community Outreach

- 35 community events
- 23 community presentations given
- The Partnership has maintained and increased our community presence by our involvement in multiple events and leadership initiatives, including: Rotary Club of Kinston, Safe Kids Eastern Carolina Coalition, Touch-A-Truck event, Vendors expo and more.

- 27 parents/guardians participated in home visits

Reach Out and Read (ROR)

- 1,461 books distributed
